Rules:	IJF Contest Rules Apply The Tournament Director reserves the right to make any changes in the best interest of the tournament and for the contestants.
Exceptions:	(A) "Headlock" throws will not be permitted. Koshi Guruma done correctly is allowed. (B) No double knee drop Seoi nage in U15 and all Novice Divisions. (C) No shime-waza U 15 or kansetsu-waza U 17 and all Novice Divisions. (D) IJF Rules apply to all gripping and blocking below the belt. First contact result will be awarded Shido, Second infraction will result in Hansoku-make of current match. (E) Red Mats are included in Contest Area. Three metre safety zone is outside the Red Tatami. (F) Masters and Novice will be granted leniency for medical interventions and decisions in event of a tie based on best of three judging rather than "Golden Score". (G) "Golden Score" will apply in all Junior Boys and Girls, Juvenile Men & Women, Junior Men and Women, Senior Men & Women. (H) Rest time between matches equal to match times. (I) Blue Judogi is encouraged and to be worn by competitor called first.
Judogi/Uniforms:	IJF fitting rules apply. Remove all metal objects from your body including undergarments and hair. Women are to wear a plain white T-shirt with no logos or writing. All nail polish or face make-up shall be removed prior to the contest.
Match Times:	U13 - 2.5 minutes U15 - 3 minutes U17 - 4 minutes U20 - 4 minutes Seniors - 5 minutes Masters - 3 minutes
Weigh - In:	Venue Gym (between Officials Room & Contest Area) 8 AM to 8:45 AM - All Novice and U13 8:30 AM to 9:15 AM - U15 & U17 9 AM to 10 AM - U20, Seniors
Medal Presentations:	4:00 PM - All Divisions You must be in full Judogi to receive your medals.
Concession:	There will be a concession for all athletes and spectators at the tournament site. We will be hosting a nutritious line of snacks and lunch cuisine.
Grand Champion:	If you are Yellow belt to Blue belt, U17 and older, and take a gold or silver medal in your regular division, you may enter the Grand Championships. Male and Female Grand Champion will receive a \$250 Bursary for First Place.
