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ELIGIBILITY

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION (Eligibility Requirements):

Individual competition is open to any male or female born before **Dec. 31, 2003**, with the following restrictions:

1. ALL CONTESTANTS must be a resident of California
2. ALL CONTESTANTS must be a current member of at least one of the following organizations and have current insurance coverage with that organization on the day of competition: United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association or USA Judo. **Copy of passport or government issued birth certificate required. Membership card of USJF, USJA or USA Judo.**
3. NO AGE WAIVERS will be CONSIDERED or ACCEPTED. **Except for Juvenile B wishing to compete in IJF Junior (See Consent of Weight / Age Consent Form).**
4. If the contestant holds a recognized rank of Shodan (1st degree Black Belt) or higher, from USJF, USJA or USA Judo or Recognized National Federation, you must have **copy of rank certificate or copy of current USA JUDO membership card having the rank verification symbol "V" printed following the rank required.**
5. If the contestant's rank is lower than Shodan, the Certificate Regarding Non-Black Belt contestants must be completed and signed by a coach who holds a recognized Black Belt rank (**Copy of Coach's Black Belt rank**) is required.
6. Master Division: 30 yrs and Older

KATA COMPETITION (Eligibility Requirements):

1. Any combination of male, female, or mixed pairs who meet the requirements specified under the individual competition eligibility requirements.
2. Kata teams may have US and International team members.

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TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN & WEIGH-IN

TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN (ALL COMPETITORS) and WALK-UP REGISTRATION:

All contestants (Shiai and Kata) must check-in to register and weigh-in on Friday, May 27, in person at the Tournament Site. During Tournament Check-in, all late and incomplete registrations will be required to properly complete all forms and pay appropriate fees.

Satellite weigh-in option for Pre-Registered Competitors ONLY (see page 7).

TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN (COACHES & REFEREES):

All Coaches **CAN** register on Friday, May 27, in person, or on Saturday, May 28 prior to the Coaches Meeting. During Tournament Check-in, coaches will be required to properly complete late and incomplete forms and pay appropriate fees and show proof of current membership in USJF, USJA or USA Judo.

All Referees are to Check-in, in person at the Tournament Site on May 27 or May 28 at the referee meeting and show proof of current membership in USJF, USJA or USA Judo.

WEIGH-INS (ALL COMPETITORS):

Practice scales will be available to all contestants to check their weights, as many times as desired from 12 noon to 4:00 pm. on day of registration. Female weigh-in will be in Room 310 and Male weigh-in will be in Room 207. Once the “**Official Weigh-in**” begins, contestants will be allowed **ONE** chance on the scale.

COACHES CREDENTIALS

Coach’s badges will be provided to national certified coaches **ONLY** (USJF, USJA or USA Judo). In order to expedite the registration process, coaches must send Coaches Badge Application Forms to the address printed on the form. **Coaches without their credential will be charged \$50 for their bracelet.**

Coaches admitted to the floor of the event are expected to dress appropriately for a State Championship level event (i.e. dress slacks and golf or polo shirts or warm-up suits preferred. No tank tops, cut-offs shorts or T-shirts).

ALL Coaches can check-in on Friday, May 27, 2011 between 4 pm and 9 pm.

Coaching bracelets will be available during check-in on Friday or during coaches meeting on Saturday, May 28, 11:00am

No Coaches bracelets will be issued after the start of competition.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION RULES

The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the Contest Rules, Organization Code and the Sporting Code of the International Judo Federation, as modified for the 2011 California State Championships as follows:

- **SHIME-WAZA: (chokes)** is allowed in **Juvenile A, B and IJF Junior divisions ONLY** and Sr. Novice, Brown, Black Belt and Masters Division.
- **KANSETSU-WAZA (arm-locks)** is allowed in IJF Jr. Division and **Black Belt and Masters divisions ONLY**.
- **MATCH LENGTHS:** Bantam, Intermediate, Juvenile A , Jr. Novice, Sr. Novice – 3 minutes
- **MATCH LENGTHS:** Juvenile B, IJF Junior and Brown/Black Belt Division – 5 minutes
- **MATCH LENGTHS:** Masters (30 yrs and older) – 3 minutes
- **GOLDEN SCORE:** The Golden Score (sudden victory) overtime rule will be in effect – 2 minutes all divisions.
- **INJURY RULE:** Decisions as to whether an athlete may continue if injured while on the mat are to be resolved in accordance with IJF rules. Such decisions occurring off the mat or not covered by the IJF rules are to be made by the coach, the athlete, and the team doctor. If there is not a unanimous opinion among these three individuals, the athlete MAY NOT continue.
- **JUDO GI COLOR:** The wearing of a Blue judo gi by the “blue” side competitor will be required for IJF Junior and IJF Junior Open categories. For all other categories it will be OPTIONAL. The “white” side competitor MUST wear a white judo gi. Competitors are responsible for appearing in the correct color gi. Under no circumstances shall both competitors be allowed to compete in blue gis, nor will the blue and white competitors be allowed to switch positions. The gi jacket and pants must be the same color; no mixing of colors. In all matches where both competitors are wearing white gis, both competitors will remove their grade belts and wear a blue or white belt to identify the contestant’s designated color for the match.
- **COMPETITORS and THEIR COACHES:** are responsible for providing their own blue and white belt for this competition. This rule will insure that the belts fit properly. Please mark your belts with your name or club.
- **A COMPETITOR MAY COMPETE IN ONE DIVISION ONLY** according to their year of birth and official weight, with the following exceptions:
 1. For Bantam and Intermediate divisions ONLY. If a contestant’s division is uncontested, the player may move up one weight category where there are matches if consent for weight division change has been given by parent/legal guardian (See Consent for Competition Bracket Change Form). Any changes must be made prior to the start of the draw.
 2. Juvenile B contestants may compete in the IJF Junior division **instead of**, or in **addition to**, the Juvenile B division. Juvenile B Novice contests may compete in the Sr. Novice division **instead of**, or in **addition to**, the Juvenile B Novice division. Those who choose to compete in both categories must fill out TWO (2) entry forms and pay TWO (2) fees.

The above listed exceptions **MAY ONLY** be applied with the written consent of the parents/legal guardians of the contestants under the age of 18 years old. Refer to the Consent for Competition Bracket Change Form.

The 2011 California State Judo Championships Tournament Committee, which includes the Tournament Director, CJI President and the Chairs of the Development and Standards Committee, has the authority to make any changes appropriate for the betterment of the tournament. Coaches, Instructors, and Parents will have an opportunity to review the categories and confirm their child’s/athlete’s suitability for participation.

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➤ **METHOD OF COMPETITION**

These Championships will be using the following:

- Divisions with 6 or more athletes - Straight Double Elimination System
- 5 athletes or less – Round Robin
- 2 athletes – Best of 2 out of 3
 - Tie breakers
 - Head to Head Competition
- Points based on level of win. Ippon=10, Waza-ari=7, Yuko=5, No-score decision=1

➤ **SEEDING OF ATHLETES, DRAW PROCEDURES AND SCHEDULING**

- There will be NO seeding of athletes.
- The draw will be conducted using approved software. The draw will be random, with the restriction that players having the same club affiliation will be placed as far apart in the bracket as possible.
- The TEXAS MATCH CARD system will be used. Contestants will receive a card specifying their contest area number (mat #) and match number.

➤ **MATCH NUMBERING SYSTEM**

- Pools will be posted at the Venue and online at www.caljudoinc.org as soon as possible after the close of designated weigh-ins.
- Coaches please check the draw sheets to make sure your players are in their correct brackets)
- Competitors are required to report to the match 3 matches before their number.

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INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION CATEGORIES AND WEIGHT DIVISIONS

- Please note that each Category is based solely on the year in which the contestant was born. The contestant's actual age on the day of competition is irrelevant. All weights listed below are in kilograms. For each weight division, the weight range will be over the next lower weight and up to and including the weight listed.
- Example: Bantam 27 kg – over 23 kg and up to and including 27 kg.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make changes in the highest and lowest weigh classes in the BANTAM and INTERMEDIATE divisions when it is in the best interest of the contestants to make these changes due to differences in weights.
